

## **Movie: Night of the Comet**

Type of Zombies: Sci-fi space ray pseudozombies.

Watch the film as a group. Whenever someone cringes or yells at the screen, odds are good that a valuable lesson can be gleaned from the events that caused it. 14. Don't assign important tasks to one inept person.
15. If your base is infiltrated by attackers, check your vehicles for booby traps.
16. Don't use a convertible escape car.
17. Don't stop in the middle of an almost successful escape, to watch the pretty explosions.
